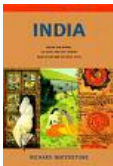

Through Matching Grants, The Rotary Foundation matches contributions raised for international service projects by Rotary clubs and districts in two or more countries. These are often World Community Service (WCS) projects. The Foundation provides a one-to-one match for District Designated Fund/SHARE contributions and a US\$0.50 match for every new \$1 cash contribution. Grant awards range from \$5,000 to \$150,000.
