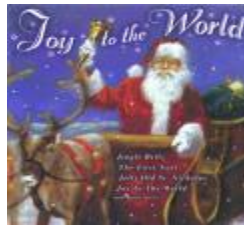




**ANNOUNCEMENTS – DECEMBER 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2008**
