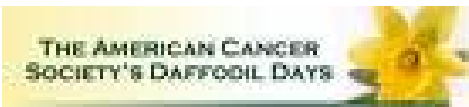

February 28th: *“Matching Grants”*, Jill Spencer. Through Matching Grants, The Rotary Foundation matches contributions raised for international service projects by Rotary clubs and districts in two or more countries. These are often World Community Service (WCS) projects. The Foundation provides a one-to-one match for District Designated Fund/SHARE contributions and a US\$0.50 match for every new \$1 cash contribution. Grant awards range from \$5,000 to \$150.00.

The Tustin-Santa Ana Rotary Club is excited to be a co-sponsor for the planning matching grant with Orange North and other Rotary clubs from our District #5320. The project will provide computers, printers, projection equipment for a middle school in Ciudad Delicias, Chihuahua, Mexico and the Rotary Club of Cd.
