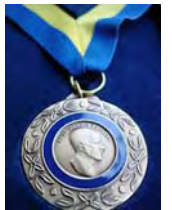

The Roger G. Hauser Medical Scholarship fund was established by Choong H. Baick, M.D., as a memorial to Roger G. Hauser, M.D. who died prematurely at the highest point of his productive life. Dr. Hauser was very interested in learning processes of young people. As a result, the purpose of this fund is primarily for education, with emphasis on students who are committed to medicine as physicians. Criteria have been established to include local students with good academic standing and a financial need. Brian Herdeg will make the presentations.



Also, Alice LeDoux, R.I. Foundation Chair, will present **35 people Paul Harris Fellowship Awards**. Donors of \$1,000 or more to the Annual Programs Fund, Polio Plus, or the Humanitarian Grants Program, or to people who have that amount contributed in their name, can be recognized as Paul Harris Fellows.
