May 29th, 2008: Guest speaker, Janette Thomas will discuss “*The Prison Pups Program.*” In 2002, Canine Support Teams, Inc., along with Sr. Pauline Quinn, founded the first “Prison Pup Program” in CA at the CA Institution for Women (CIW) in Chino. After two months of instruction, four young pups were brought into the prison for the purpose of being cared for and trained by inmate’s trainers. Since that time, the program has grown from four pups and 10 inmates to 20 pups/adolescent dogs and 63 inmate trainers! The pups/dogs selected to participate in this program are being trained to be Assistance Dogs for members of the disabled community. It is a coveted program and all inmates are subjected to a thorough screening process and file review before being accepted.



Sunday, June 1st, 2008: The Tustin Street Fair and Chili Cook Off will take to the streets of Old Town Tustin, El Camino Real and Main Street, on Sunday, June 1st from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. This 24th annual event features the Chili Cook-off, craft booths, non-profit food vendors, entertainment, kids carnival, music and much more.
