Today, August 14, 2008: Assistant District Governor, Ray Sanford, will perform the induction ceremony, accompanied by sponsor Larry LeDoux, for new member Dr. Bitia Saleh. Guest speaker is Bob Belloli; his topic is ***“Second Harvest Food Bank.”*** The primary work of the Food Bank is acquiring and distributing donated and surplus food. Food sources include local grocery stores and supermarket chains, food manufacturers and distributors, the government, restaurants, trade shows, gleaned efforts, food drives and private individuals. In partnership with 390 member charities, the Food Bank helps feed an average of 200,000 individuals each month. Those served include the working poor, children, seniors on fixed incomes, single parents, the disabled, the homeless and individuals experiencing medical emergencies or recent job layoffs.



August 19-23, 2008: Broadway in the Park. The Music Man will be running nightly Tuesday, August 19th through Saturday, August 23rd, 2008. It is a fully produced Broadway Musical which has an outdoor production at Peppertree Park, Old Town Tustin (First Street at B Street).

The new library will feature: More than double the size of the existing facility; Increased reader seating by 223 reader seats; A plaza with outdoor reading area; A professional learning center and multi-purpose programming space; 99 public use computer stations with advanced research capabilities; Private studying and tutoring rooms; Separate children and young adult area; and Expanding library collections including books and DVDs.
